

Instructions

The criteria presented herein assess the SECAPs' structure, development, and implementation.

Compliance is evaluated through different questions linked to those criteria. By running the analysis, an overall peformance is obtained, leading to a results infographic that can be printed out if wished so.

The criteria are presented in questions, which are to be answered with a "Yes" or a "No", whether there is compliance with the criteria or not. If there is reasonable progress but not fullfillment choose "Partially".

To answer the questions, click on the buttons on the right hand side of the question.

Select the "Yes" **button** if that specific requirement was fulfilled.

If the requirement was not fulfilled or the task was not executed, select the "No" button.

If the **requirement** was partially fulfilled, select the "Partially" button.








