How to get the most from your renovation

Ventilation and air quality

- ✓ Keep ventilation openings clear
- ✓ Replace filters regularly
- ✓ Report unusual noise or odour

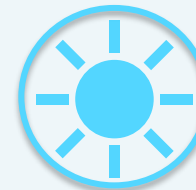


Heating

- ✓ Avoid overheating (set 20–22°C)
- ✓ Use thermostats correctly
- ✓ Do not cover radiator

Moisture & Mould

- ✓ Ventilate after cooking and showering
- ✓ Report leaks immediately
- ✓ Watch for condensation



Summer Comfort

- ✓ Use shading where available
- ✓ Ventilate during cooler hours
- ✓ Reduce overheating

Energy Monitoring

- ✓ Follow energy consumption
- ✓ Compare bills over time
- ✓ Investigate unusual increases
